PROJECT DESCRIPTION

As a follow up to the risk assessments and evaluations executed for Murphy Oil Corporation in May 2005, the Kikeh Gas Pipeline Project management requested further support regarding review and assessment of the status at that moment of the new building pipelay and heavy lift vessel Sapura 3000.

The Sapura 3000, operated by TL Offshore / Acergy, has been selected for the installation of the 120-kilometre Kikeh Gas Pipeline. Objective of this review was the prediction of the earliest possible starting date for the Kikeh project.

The construction progress of several platform supply vessels, had to be reviewed with the objective to indicate the expected completion dates of each vessel, so Murphy Oil could verify whether the actual delivery dates matched the dates when the vessels were needed.
